Dover Operating Corp. becomes Brion Energy

CALGARY, May 31, 2013 – Dover Operating Corp. has changed its name to Brion Energy to reflect a growing company with assets that extend beyond the Dover Project. The name change is effective May 31, 2013. The near-term impetus for the change was a legal challenge from another entity that owns the name “Dover,” and the timing was good because the former name had become too narrow to represent the company and its values adequately.

“Brion Energy is a truly modern Canadian energy company,” said Brion President and Chief Executive Officer Zhiming Li. “Like the country itself, we are young, multicultural and resource-rich. We’re growing quickly and seeking the brightest and most creative minds to join us in our next phases of growth.”

The word Brion (which rhymes with “ion”) means noble. As a company that focuses on operational excellence and constant improvement, Brion Energy strives to be unified, honourable, passionate and conscientious. The logo treatment, with an upper case sans serif font, denotes a contemporary, progressive, professional company. The green dot over the “i” represents people, financial value and environmental performance.

The name change to Brion Energy reflects the company’s growth plans. As a joint venture between PetroChina Co. and Athabasca Oil Corp., Brion plans to produce 400,000 barrels of oil per day from its Mackay River and Dover oil sands assets by 2025.
